Sub: Fifth Meeting of National Working Group-9 (NWG-9) corresponding to the ITU-T Study Group 9 (SG9) for Study Period 2022-24 regarding "Broadband Cable and TV": Reg.

The first meeting of ITU-T SG9 was held from 6th to 14th September 2022 in fully virtual mode. The Indian delegation attended this SG9 meeting was headed by NWG-9 Chairman Sh. Avinash Agarwal, DDG (C&B), TEC and other members of the delegation were Dr. Pradipta Biswas, Asst. Professor – Vice-Chair NWG-9, Mr. Rajiv Khattar, Maj. Gen. Dr. Pritam Bishnoi, TSDSI, Sh. Rakesh Desai, Dir (C&B-II) TEC, Ms Meenakshi Singhvi, Prasar Bharti, Mr Pallab Dutta, C-DOT, Mr Aftab Alam, ADG (C&B).

- 2. SG9 meeting has approved NWG-9, India contributions in r/o Q.1/9, 2/9 and 11/9 and our contributions resulted into initiating four new work items one Recommendation on CAS, and three Technical Reports, one each on CAS, Wi-Fi TV, and Live Captioning. The SG-9 has also planned various interim Rapporteurs meetings during October 2022 to February 2023 to discuss the progress on new / ongoing work items.

It is also proposed that the Working Parties (WPs)/ Working Groups (WGs) may be formed in respect of different Questions of SG9 and each WP/ WG would handle 2-3 Questions. It is envisaged that the proposed WPs/ WGs would further help NWG-9 in building the four (4) approved work items and prepare the inputs / comments consolidating the views of the subject experts on other ongoing work items in respect of remaining questions. Hence, NWG-9 members are requested to come forward for such focused WPs/ WGs and submit their nominations by 7th October 2022. The Chairpersons and members of WPs/ WGs will be finalised during the forthcoming NWG-9 meeting dated 11th October 2022.
- 6. The NWG-9 members are requested to furnish their inputs / comments on the above-stated work items before the meeting dated 11/10/2022 on dircb2.tec-dot@gov.in with copy to avinash.70@gov.in.
- 7. The NWG-9 Members are also requested to identify relevant experts from the Academia, startups, industry, OEMs, etc and mail the requisite information in this regard at the earliest so that such experts can be included in NWG-9 group and accordingly invited for the fifth meeting of NWG-9.
