Proposal in brief

- a. Switzerland has proposed some revisions in (a) the Ordinance on *telecommunications installations (OIT)*, and (b) *the Ordinance of the Swiss Federal Office of Communications on telecommunications installations (OOIT)*.
- b. The OIT and OOIT ordinances specify the basic technical requirements with regard to telecommunications installations.
- c. The following Radiocommunication installations referred to in art. 7 para 2bis, ILO must be compatible with a universal charging device with load capacities as mentioned in part 2 of Annex 7:
 - i. Mobile phones
 - ii. Tablets
 - iii. Headphones
 - iv. Headsets
 - v. Digital cameras
 - vi. Portable speakers
 - vii. Handheld video game consoles
 - viii. e-readers
 - ix. Keyboards
 - x. Mice
 - xi. Portable navigation systems
 - xii. Earbuds and
 - xiii. Laptops

Analysis

- a. Transitional provision relating to the modification of the Radiocommunication installations that do not meet the essential requirements set out in art. 7 para. 2bis, 19, para. 2 let. d, and 3, and 24a may be made available on the market until the following dates: a. laptops: 26 April 2026 and for other radiocommunication installations: 28 December 2024.
- b. The said ordinance shall come into force on January 1, 2024.
- c. Stakeholders are likely to offer comments on or before 16 October 2023.
